- Meta-analysis of parenteral nutrition versus enteral nutrition in patients with acute pancreatitis.
- Bone turnover during inpatient nutritional therapy and outpatient follow-up in patients with *anorexia nervosa* compared with that in healthy control subjects.
- Malnutrition is an independent factor associated with nosocomial infections.
- Effects of a low-fat diet compared with those of a high-monounsaturated fat diet on body weight, plasma lipids and lipoproteins, and glycemic control in type 2 diabetes.

- Possition of the American Dietetic Association: functional foods.
- Effects of differing phenolic content in dietary olive oils on lipid and LDL oxidation. A randomized controlled trial.
- Acute Rhodiola Rosea intake can improve endurance exercise performance.
- Diet, physical activity, and sedentary behaviours as risk factors for overweight in adolescence.
- No long-term benefits of supplementation with arabinoglactan on serum lipids and glucose.

- Refeeding syndrome in patients with gastrointestinal fistula.
- Dietary composition of pregnant women related to size of the baby at the birth.
- Very low fat (12%) and high monounsaturated fat (35%) diets do not differentiality affect abdominal fat loss in overweight, nondiabetic women.
- Dietary fat acids affect plasma markers on inflammation in healthy men fed controlled diets: a randomized crossover study.
- Glucose-based total parenteral nutrition does not stimulate glucose uptake by humans tumours.
